

RYA Powerboat Level 2 (The RYA Level One award is incorporated into the course).

Conducted over two days, the course assumes no previous knowledge, but is designed to provide thorough instruction and coverage of powerboat handling techniques. The course includes low-speed and high-speed manoeuvring as well as the background knowledge needed to use a powerboat safely.

It also allows eligible persons to apply for the International Certificate of Competence for power vessels up to 10 metres in length, which includes PWCs/ Jet Skis.

The RYA Levels Two National Powerboat Certificate is also considered equivalent to the French Permis Cotier and allows the holder to use a French registered boat or PWC/Jet Ski.

The RYA Level Two Powerboat Certificate is recognised by the UK MCA as a 'Tender driving licence' for professional yacht crew and can be commercially endorsed.

We run this course from Beaulieu sur Mer, between Nice & Monaco.
